7 Managing User Accounts

7.1 Concept: Users, Roles, and Permissions

- Users:
 - 3 Groups
 - "anonymous" = not logged in
 - "authenticated" = logged in
 - "User 1" = the admin account from installation
- Permission
 - whether a user may perform an action / small set of actions
 - has a name e.g. "View published content"
 - defined by the module that provides the actions
- Role
 - group of permissions
 - "Anonymous user"
 - "Authenticated user"
 - optionally: "Administrator" all permissions (automatically)
- User Account
 - automatically: "Authenticated user" role
 - may be assigned more roles
 - Effect: the user has the permissions of the roles

7.2 Concept: The User 1 Account

- named "admin"
- has permission to do all actions, independent of what roles it is assigned
- = "root user" in Linux
- cannot be deleted via admin user interface
- ! prefer to use a separate account with "Administrator" role!

7.5 Assigning Permissions to a Role [Manage - People - Roles - Edit permissions](#) checkboxes for permissions

7.6 Changing a User's Roles [Manage - People - Edit](#) Username "admin": add role "Administrator"
Check multiple users, select bulk action from "With selection" list

7.7 Assigning Authors to Content [Manage - Content, select content item, click "Edit", "Authored by"](#)

8 Blocks

8.1 Concept: Blocks

- pieces of layout
- placed inside regions of the theme
- e.g. main navigation menu, main page content, "Who's online"
- some modules make new blocks available e.g. Search module: block with search form
- you can create and place your own custom blocks
- has own configuration settings
 - which pages display the block
 - even multiple copies, with separate configuration

8.2 Creating a Custom Block

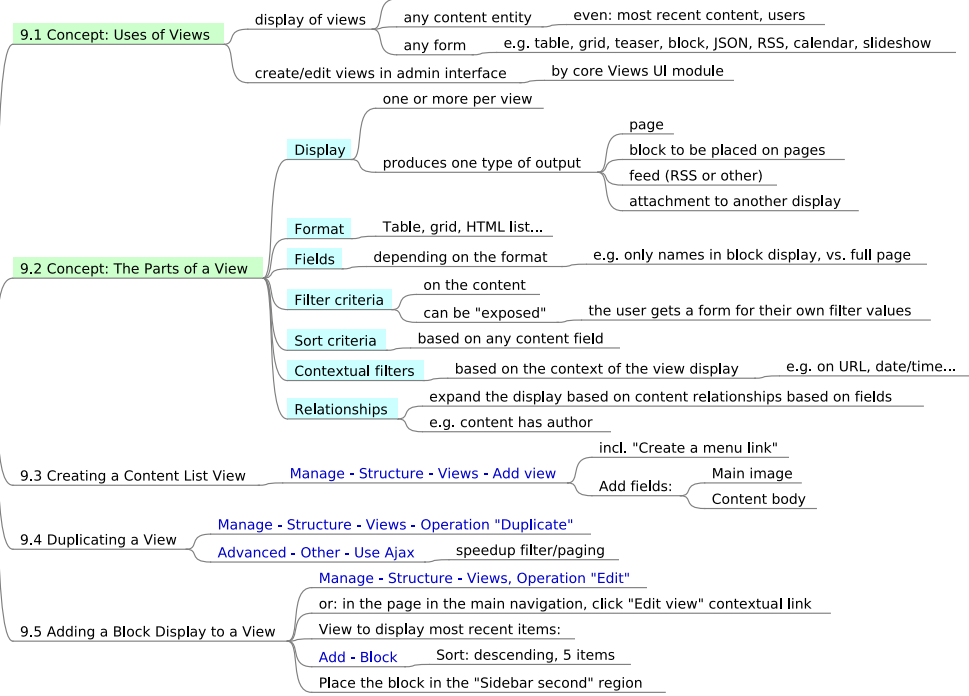
- [Manage - Structure - Block layout - Custom block library - Add custom block](#)
- Under "Body": enter HTML text

8.3 Placing a Block in a Region

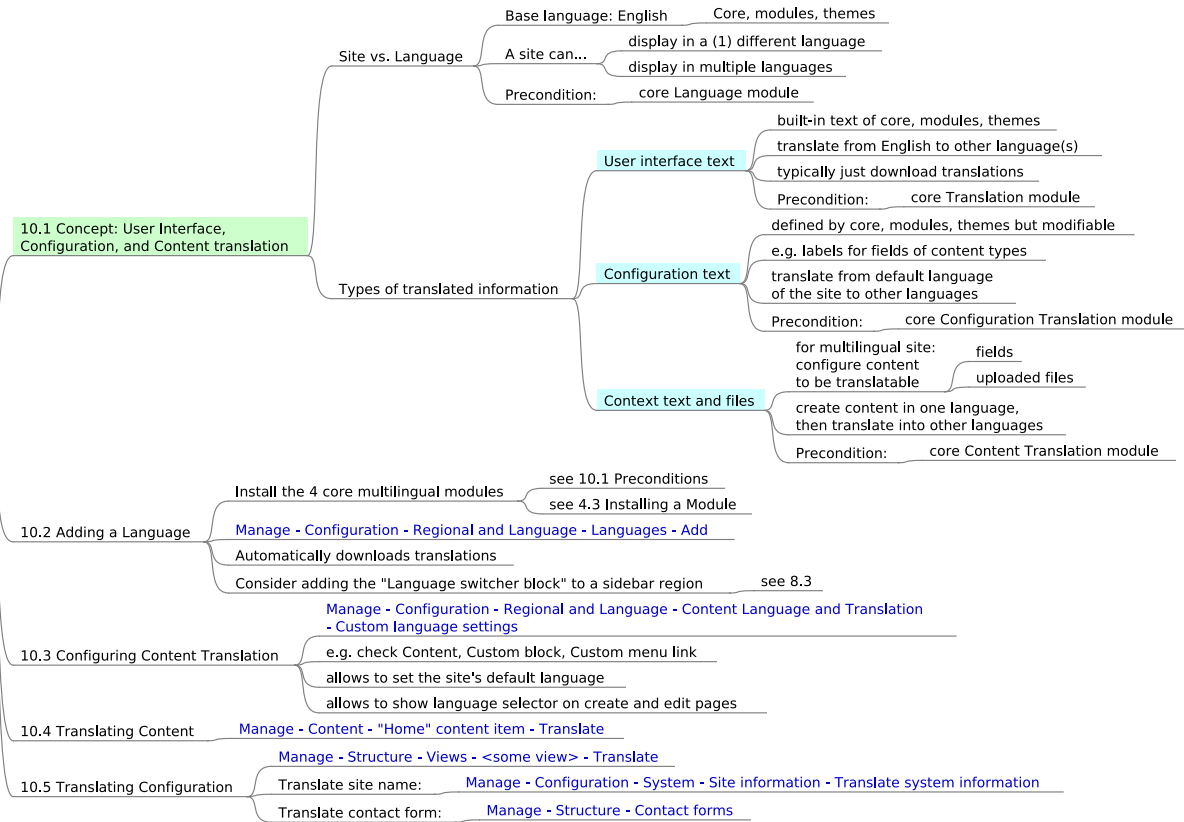
- [Manage - Structure - Block layout](#)
- Secondary tab: ensure Bartik theme is selected
- Locate region "Sidebar second", click "Place block"
- Practice
 - Remove "Powered by Drupal" block from the "Footer" region set region "- None -"
 - Remove "Tools" block from "Sidebar first" region (only visible to logged in users)
 - Place the "User login" block in a region
